

## Part Two Moving to New Premises Chrestos Christian Education Centre 2005-2006

In July 2005, twenty-six students were studying at the Centre and we realized that if the numbers continued to increase we would have to find new accommodation. We prayed, and over a period of four to five months we looked at over twenty places, but each one proved unsuitable for some reason. In May 2006 we were just thinking that we would have to settle for a small plot of land on the other side of town from the team house, when, by the Lord's grace, four acres next to the team house became available at a price that we could afford. Just at the time when the hospital wing had become too small for our growing number of students. We built toilets, leveled a football field, and turned the warehouse into an auditorium.



### Students at Work

This property has a large warehouse that housed the largest rice-mill in Mae Sariang. At our request, the owners took the rice-mill with them. Then, with the help of our hard-working students, it was transformed into an auditorium seating about four hundred people. It was repainted, a

stage was built, and fans, lights and a PA system were added.

## Chrestos Christian Educational Centre 2006-2007

In July 2006, we dedicated the new property to God for His purposes and four of our women students graduated after two years of study. We opened our new term with thirty eight students, and started to build two new dormitories and a kitchen/dining room.
